Puppy contracts and invoices were sent out via DocuSign for electronic signatures. Please take some time and review the contracts. Please let me know if you have any questions prior to signing the contracts. Please sign the puppy contract prior to puppy pick up day or at please bring a phone with you so you can sign it when you are here.

As soon as we know which puppy you are taking we will sign our portion of the contract and enter the microchip number to the contract as well. Once both of us have signed the contract with the correct microchip information, DocuSign will email both of us a fully executed contract in a PDF format.

We are the VERY last house at the end of the street. You will come to the end of a cul-de-sac. At the very end of it there will be a small road that shoots off to the west. This road takes you to our place. You must pass through the black iron gate in order to get to our home. Once you pass through the gate (with Golden Retrievers on it) there will be a road that goes up to the main house on the right hand side please and a gravel road that continues on down to the barn. Please head on down to the guest house down by the barn.

Couple of rules for visiting with the puppies:

1. Puppy pick up days are SUPER busy for us. We are usually doing all the last minute stuff to include washing all babies. Puppy pick up will start right at the time listed on the schedule. Please check for your name. There is a local coffee shop in Hockinson if you arrive early. Coffee shop is north of our home on NE 182nd Ave right in Hockinson. Good coffee! ❤️
2. Please take your shoes off and leave them on the Shoe rack once you enter into the puppy room of the guest house. No shoes in the house. We take Parvo-virus very serious.
3. Before puppies we must have everyone wash their hamds. There will be someone here to guide you to the right spot for hand sanitation.

4. We recently started having a meeting prior to everyone meeting the puppies. We go over any questions you may have and give you a little orientation to the puppies, their development and review food, supplements, vaccinations and spay/neuter. This process takes about an hour. If you are bringing children please bring along another parent or friend that can take care of the kids. I really need full undivided attention for about one hour. Sometimes it takes less but if we figure an hour we know we will be good for sure.

Please know that we love kids and kids are absolutely welcome for the puppy portion but we have found that giving this little orientation helps make the puppy pick up day go so much smoother. And I have a voice at the end of the day as I am not repeating the same information 10 times. 😊 So for me it's a win/win! We have had some older people get upset with us for allowing children to puppy pick ups. I firmly believe that if your household has children I would honestly prefer to have them here for the selection process. We need to make sure that the puppies are comfortable with your children as well as your children comfortable with a puppy. So, we just ask that if you are bringing children along please just make sure that there is someone else with you that can care for them as sitting with anticipation of meeting the puppies can be a bit overwhelming for the kids. It's difficult enough on the parents 😊

5. We ask that if you are holding a puppy you are sitting on the floor. We had a visitor last summer that was standing on concrete holding a puppy and the puppy wiggled and caught them by surprise and landed on his head. **No puppies on the couch please.**
6. Children are welcome but we ask that you please supervise. Children should NOT be standing holding a puppy. Puppies are very wiggly and will leap out of their arms and hurt themselves.
7. Please do not sit the puppies on the couch and leave them. They will fall off. **No puppies on the couch please.**

8. There will be a selection order, it is the order in which deposits were received. But we ask that everyone works together to ensure that everyone INCLUDING the last puppy pick has a puppy that they feel a connection with. So, far we have a 100% success rate of everyone working extremely well together to ensure that everyone's feelings are taken into consideration. ❤️ I NEVER want a family leaving feeling like they got the left over puppies. There is NO SUCH THING in our home as a LEFT OVER puppy. All of these puppies are beautiful and just a bundle of love. All of these puppies will have an opinion of you as well as I'm sure you will of them too 😊 Some will be indifferent to you, some will be all over you. Some may not like you. We MUST respect the process. 😊
9. Before you leave our home you will want to register your puppies microchip #. Please visit <https://www.akcreunite.org>. This is IMPORTANT. For some reason people have not been registering their microchip and to me this is really dangerous. Reunite has my contact information on file. So, they will always be able to reach me but I may not live so close to you and if your puppy gets lost you want to be reunited with your pup as soon as possible. So, we are now asking that while I'm filling out the microchip information and signing the contract that you are pulling up on your phone and registering your puppies microchip number with your contact information. We will have a computer setup for you to register the chip if it's easier for you. You will need a credit card to complete this process.
10. We will have Trupanion Insurance binders ready for you. You are receiving 1 month of free pet insurance for you puppy. You must call in and register your puppy within 24 hours of puppy pick up. We always recommend that everyone register your puppy before you leave our house. That way you do not get busy and forget to do so. I highly recommend that everyone keep pet insurance for at least the first year. During your first year you will be getting immunizations and several vet visits through this process. Not to mention you will also need a spay or a neuter somewhere between 18-24 months. And most ER visits are with puppies. The eat stuff... and until you are trained to

keep everything picked up and out of reach I would keep insurance 😊 Not to mention Parvo if your puppy gets Parvo you will want insurance. Parvo usually only happens when they are puppies and not fully vaccinated.

11. We hope you enjoy puppy pick up day. Puppy pick up day is so much fun! It makes what we do the best part. Through our puppies we've had the opportunity to meet so many families that we would have never had the opportunity to meet. Have fun and enjoy the puppy time, and welcome to the Moonlit Acres family!

We usually do puppy pick-ups early mornings on Fridays. However, this puppy pick up is catching us in the middle of a residential move. So, we are hoping that a Thursday pick up day is going to work with everyone. So, here is what we have planned for puppy pick up times:

June 13 at 10 AM: Cali & Lily Families. Since there are only two boys in the litters we will start with the boy families with the selection process. Dibble & Peterson will be first. We will have blue collars on them to help identify them easier amongst ALL the tankish girls! 😊

We are excited to meeting everyone. Puppy pick up days are amazing! **So much fun...** If you have any questions or if you get lost please call me on my cell. Again, we are the **VERY** last house at the end of the street. Once you pull into our driveway and pass the gate please follow the gravel driveway down to the end. We will have just moved to the guest house for the summer. Come on through the little white gate and come into the garage. PLEASE, drive slowly coming into the subdivision. Puppy pick up days create a lot of extra traffic for my neighbors so please be respectful of my neighbors and drive slow - thanks! 😊

Lastly, here is a link that will provide you with a ton of information. Grab a cup of coffee and make sure you have some time.
